Department of Work and Pensions

The Department for Work and Pensions (DWP) is responsible for welfare, pensions and child maintenance policy. As the UK's biggest public service department, it administers the State Pension and a range of working age, disability and ill health benefits to around 20 million claimants and customers

School and College Advisers will provide support to schools, FE colleges, 6th forms, specialist schools and PRU's assisting them in their statutory duty to deliver independent, high quality and impartial careers advice to students aged 12 to 18 and students who have an 'Education Health and Care Plan' (EHCP) aged 16 - 24. The support is aimed at those young people identified as being at risk of becoming NEET or who might otherwise be disadvantaged in the labour market (for example those with a health condition / disability or from a BAME background). School and College Advisers will work in partnership with the Careers and Enterprise Company and other stakeholders to ensure Jobcentre Plus builds on support already available to schools. The support is demand-led and will vary depending on the requirements of the individual school/college.
